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Beau's Bridge Club Foster Guidelines

1. Only designated BBC staff shall approve and place rescued animals into foster homes. BBC staff must be notified as soon as possible of any changes in the status of either the animal in your care or the foster home environment you have indicated above.
2. All animals placed in foster care will be examined by the BBC approved veterinarian, and will have been given/will be given all necessary immunizations, and either already or will be scheduled to be spayed or neutered.
3. All basic medical and general expenses will be covered by BBC. Authorized BBC staff must approve any unusual expenses. Basics include: Spay/neuter, age-appropriate vaccinations, heartworm test, FelV/FIV test, microchip, and prescribed medications. Basic supplies include: Dog- collar, tag and leash, food, and toys. Cat - food, litter, litter box, and toys. Sleeping or carrying crates and bowls will be provided as necessary.
4. A BBC foster dog must wear his/her ID Tag at all times (except underage puppies who do not go home with collars), and must be on a leash or in a secure pet carrier when outside of its foster home or its enclosed yard. During transport, the rescued animal must ride inside the car. A BBC foster cat must live indoors only.
5. Beau's Bridge Club must be notified immediately if the animal in your care is injured or missing.
6. Legal ownership of all BBC animals remains with BBC until such time as proper adoption is completed. No rescued animal may be adopted, transferred, or relinquished without the approval by authorized staff of BBC.
7. Only authorized representatives of BBC will conduct adoption interviews and process adoptions.



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8. Adoptions will be deemed finalized only after completion of the Adoption Contract and receipt of the adoption fee.

9. If a foster home decides to adopt the foster cat /dog, it is agreed that he/she will pay the full adoption fee and complete an Adoption Contract.

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Foster Emergency Protocol Waiver

Please follow these instructions, should a BBC foster animal require emergency attention after standard office hours (Mon-Fri 8:30am-5:30pm):

1. Please call BBC immediately at 510-556-1921. If not answered upon first call, hang up and call again. If not answered the second time, please leave a message. This phone number cycles through several staff members at BBC, so chances are it should get answered on the first call. Just in case, though, make sure you do call again. If you cannot get through on the second try, it most likely means we are on the phone with someone else having an emergency.
2. **If** you get clearance to go to the emergency clinic, you may take your foster to the location BBC staff specifies to you on the phone. We have agreements with several veterinarians and would like you to go to one of those if it is within practical distance of your location. You must receive authorization from BBC first and they will call the Emergency Center so they will be expecting you.

Failure to comply with our protocol will result in deactivation as a foster, and you will be responsible for any charges incurred.
